Units Goals and Objectives:

Goal 1: To develop a quality system for conscious, consistent and catalytic programmed action to improve the academic and administrative performance of IIU:

Objectives:

- a. Development and application of quality benchmarks/parameters for various academic and administrative activities of the university
- b. Arrangement of feedback responses from students, parents and other stakeholders on quality-related institutional processes
- c. Acting as a nodal agency of the IIU for coordinating quality-related activities, including adoption and dissemination of good practices
- d. Bi-annual development of Quality Radars (QRs) and Ranking of Integral Units of IIU based on the AQAR;

Goal 2: To promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices;

Objectives:

- a. Development of Quality Culture in University;
- b. Creation of a learner-centric environment conducive for quality education and faculty maturation; adoption of required knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process;
- c. Dissemination of information on various quality parameters of higher education;
- d. Organization of inter and intra institutional workshops, seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles;
- e. Documentation of the various programmes/activities of the university, leading to quality improvement;
- f. Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) of the university based on the quality parameters/assessment criteria developed by the relevant quality assurance body (like NAAC, NBA, AB) in the prescribed format;
